

GIFT AID DECLARATION

When you make a Gift Aid declaration it means that the basic rate of tax can be reclaimed by PartnerAid UK if you are a UK taxpayer. So at the current rate of tax of 20%, for every £1 donated PartnerAid UK can claim an extra 25 pence. This means your donation goes further.
